1. The Concept

1.1 Objectives

- promote the Gay and Lesbian Rights Lobby and its aims ٠
- highlight the failure of successive State Governments to recognise same sex relationships
- · lobby for law reform as a key election issue

2. Description of Entry

Martian Ambassador riding on a platform ahead of a vehicle decorated with scenery to depict a Martian spaceship hovering above Macquarie Street. Surrounding this setting is the Martian Woman and 20 to 40 Martians (refer to **7.3 Transport**).

3. Organisation

The Gay and Lesbian Rights Lobby (G.L.R.L.) was formed in 1988 when a coalition government came to power in New South Wales.

The objectives of the rights lobby include :

- to protect and promote lesbian and gay rights in N.S.W.;
- to liase, support and work with other organisations to protect and promote lesbian and gay rights in Australia and internationally;
- to liase, support and work with other organisations in N.S.W. for the protection and promotion of lesbian and gay rights in this state.

4. Inspiration for the parade entry

This parade entry was inspired by Tim Burton's "Mars Attacks". Due to Bob Carr's uncanny resemblance to an alien lifeform he is represented as the Martian Ambassador who comes to Earth bearing false messages (refer to **6.1 Martian Ambassador**). As in the movie the Martians claim they come in peace however their actions illustrate their true intentions ie. "*Nice planet, we'll take it*", as have successive State Governments regarding the recognition of same sex relationships.

Kerry Chikarovski represented as the Martian Woman (refer to **6.2 Martian Woman**). Dons the "human" facade of a prostitute in order to gain the trust of the president's aide. The moral of the story being that the gay and lesbian communities should not be seduced by the notion that she and her party are a



viable alternate ally, as Peter Collins so unfortunately discovered.

The Ministry and Shadow Cabinet are the foot soldiers who carry Martian Ray Guns decorated with flags highlighting the range of attacks against our rights (refer to **7.1 Guns/Flags**).

In the movie the Martians are defeated by the music of Slim Whitman. Subject to funds, the music chosen for this entry needs to have the same relevance.


6. Characters

6.1 Martian Ambassador (Bob Carr)

1 off Martian Ambassador riding on platform attached to front bull bar of vehicle.

- martian cloak, green and purple tissue lame with spangly red not equals sign as insignia
- clear space helmet depicting Bob Carr's face with huge Martian brain illustrating massive intellect but no compassion.








6.3 Martian Ministry and Shadow Cabinet

20 to 40 off Martian Ministers and Shadow Cabinet walking around vehicle.

- disposable paper overalls dyed green with spangly red not equals insignia. Tubular foam to embellish costume to appear sci-fi in nature.
- · clear space helmet.


7. Props

7.1 Guns/flags

Martian Ray Guns with flags illustrating attacks on our rights as in the following issues :

- relationships
- parentage
- inheritance
- property ownership
- medical and hospital decisions
- IVF
- leave entitlements
- age of consent





7.2 Signage/banners

One banner at front of Entry carried by two Martians that says "Gay and Lesbian Rights Lobby Presents "Carr's Attacks"



7.3 Transport

- 1 tonne truck with bull bar tray decorated as parliament house with spaceship hovering above it.
- Platform attached to truck bullbar where the martian ambassador will stand. Red lycra "carpet" extending to the door of the spaceship.
- if funds permit will carry 8kVA generator, sound system, lighting and refreshments
- simple lighting








7.4 Ray Gun

 mounted on truck cabin emanating not equals ray beam



8. Allocation of resources
